 OF ECOLOGY APPROVAL

Attached for your approval is the subject Waste Site Reclassification Form (WSRF) 2008-001 and its verification package (Rev. 0) demonstrating this waste site meets the cleanup objectives of the interim action Record of Decision. The verification package was initially provided to Ecology for review on February 8, 2011, with revised submittals and discussions ensuing over the next 18 months. The U.S. Department of Energy Richland Operations Office (RL) has updated the supporting document to incorporate those of Ecology's comments which have been resolved.

This extensive series of pipelines carried filtered and treated supply water upstream of the 105-D Reactor facility similar in operation to that of a domestic water supply. Sampling demonstrated that the scale deposits found inside the pipelines do not represent a credible risk to human health and the environment. 
